





Pulmonary Function Test and Preparation

What is a pulmonary function test?

Pulmonary function tests measure:

- How much air your lungs can hold
- How quickly you can move air in and out of your lungs
- How well your lungs add oxygen and remove carbon dioxide from the blood

You will be asked to take deep breaths and blow into a machine. The test takes about 45 minutes.

SHOULD I TAKE MY MEDICATIONS BEFORE THE TEST?

- Take your medications as you normally do, unless the doctor who ordered the test has given you other instructions.
- If you have any questions about your medications, call your doctor for advice.

When you come for the test....

- Bring a current list of all of your medications with you to the test, including over-the-counter (non-prescription) medicines, pills, puffers and eye drops.
- Please bring in any devices you use to take your puffers.
